

If, due to injury, a bowler wants the ability to bowl with their off-hand in X-League, they must sanction with their off-hand and would take up a second roster spot. If the bowler has recent book history with the off-hand, an entering average will be calculated for them just like any new bowler to join the X-League (composite average of the two most recent seasons with that hand). If no recent sanctioned average for the off-hand exists, they would enter at 240 like any new bowler joining X-League with no recent sanctioned history. They could submit for a rerate for their off-hand after bowling 9 X-League games with their off-hand.

During the season, if a bowler is sanctioned with both hands, the team owner would need to denote which hand the bowler is bowling with when the lineup is submitted. Since the bowler is sanctioned twice, and takes up two roster spots, the change from one hand to another between games is effectively the same as subbing from Bowler A to Bowler B. As such, all normal rules about substitutions apply. This means that during competition, the bowler would NOT be allowed to change hands in the middle of the game. The bowler would however be allowed to change hands between games IF the team has a sub available.

Because each way the bowler is sanctioned functions as a separate rostered bowler, the normal add/drop rules apply. The bowler can opt out from the team for one hand and stay on the team with the other. However, just like any other bowler, once they leave the team, they cannot rejoin the team in the same season. Additionally, a bowler sanctioned with both hands cannot be sanctioned with two separate teams. If they sanction with both hands due to injury, it can only be with the same team.
